A suggested width for a footpath is 1.5 metres with a height of 2 metres.

Single cuts should normally be undertaken in June.

Two cuts: First cut should be undertaken between May and July and the second cut between August and September.

Three cuts: These are to be undertaken at a time agreed by the contractor and the Parish Council.

These dates are subject to alteration as a result of annual variance is seasonal weather conditions. The Parish Council will liaise with the contractor in respect of the timing of the work
