Not enough remains of the old clay dries to convert into a residence, and this proposal would virtually be a new build in the countryside and contrary to Policy 7. The proposed 300m access road would be a scar on the hillside. This site overlooks and is immediately adjacent to a small area of common land between Stannon stream and a rural lane. This remote but accessible spot is much appreciated by local people for its tranquillity, upland stream and open moorland landscape adjoining enclosed agriculture land. It is second in importance only to Delphy bridge, St Breward's other accessible moorland, riverside amenity area. 50% of the proposed building is in Flood Zone 3, which has a high probability of flooding and is land assessed as having a 1 in 100 or greater annual probability of river flooding.
